

# Nebraska Post-Game Notes

## Nebraska at Purdue, Oct. 31, 2015, West Lafayette, Ind.

- \* **Ryker Fyfe** made his first career start at quarterback. **Tommy Armstrong Jr.** had started the previous 22 games, since not starting against Iowa in November of 2013.
- \* Nebraska has used 20 different starters on offense this season after **Ryker Fyfe** made his first start today. Nebraska has also used 20 different starters on defense this season.
- \* **Stanley Morgan Jr.** had a 42-yard kickoff return in the second quarter, marking Nebraska's longest kickoff return of the season. The previous long was a 27-yarder by Morgan at Miami. Morgan capped the drive with a 20-yard touchdown reception, his second of the season.
- \* Nebraska place-kicker **Drew Brown** connected on a 41-yard field goal to open the scoring. Brown has nine field goals of at least 40 yards this season. Brown is 15-of-21 on field goals this season. He came into today leading the Big Ten in field goals per game.
- \* The blocked extra point by Purdue in the second quarter was the first miss of **Drew Brown's** career. Brown made the first 86 PATs of his career.
- \* **Joshua Kalu** blocked a Purdue PAT in the fourth quarter.
- \* In Nebraska's six losses this season, the Huskers are minus-12 in turnover margin.
- \* **Jordan Westerkamp** had nine receptions for a season-high 123 yards, including a 35-yard touchdown reception in the fourth quarter. Westerkamp moved into fifth place on the NU career receiving yardage list. He now has 1,688 yards and passed Todd Peterson (1,602 yards) in today's game. Westerkamp also passed Peterson on the career receptions list to move into seventh place on that list with 113 career receptions.
- \* Westerkamp has caught a pass in 22 straight games, the sixth-longest streak in Nebraska history.
- \* The nine-yard TD run by **Imani Cross** in the third quarter was the 24th of his career and second of the 2015 season.
- \* The 17-yard touchdown reception by **Lane Hovey** in the fourth quarter was the first touchdown reception of Hovey's career.
- \* The 52-yard reception by **Brandon Reilly** in the fourth quarter was a career-long reception, bettering his 49-yard reception against Southern Miss earlier this season. Reilly finished the game with five receptions for 88 yards, including an 8-yard touchdown grab in the fourth quarter.
- \* The 83-yard touchdown pass by Purdue in the third quarter was the longest play allowed by Nebraska this season. The previous long was a 68-yard run by Northwestern's Clayton Thorson last week.
- \* The Purdue victory evened the all-time series between the schools at two wins apiece.
- \* Purdue's 55 points were the most by an NU opponent this season, bettering the 36 by Miami in an overtime loss.
